Job Description		
<p>Under the direction of the Supervisor of Sludge Vessel Operations, the captain takes command of an assigned vessel and its crew and acts as the department representative in all matters concerning the vessel and its crew; performs related work. The Captain (<i>Sludge Boat</i>), will exercise independent judgment under way; pilot the sludge vessel; assign duties and responsibilities to the licensed officers and crew; Assume responsibility for the safe operation of the vessel at all time under way and in port; direct all personnel involved in mooring and unmooring vessel.</p> <p>The Captain is also responsible for proper loading and unloading operations and for the proper stowage and care of ship supplies and equipment. Keep ship logs and make necessary reports. Inspect the ship at frequent intervals and is responsible for its proper maintenance and upkeep. Instruct junior officers and crew in the proper performance of their duties and prepares them for assumption of higher duties. Keep supervisor fully informed in all matters affecting the vessel and its crew. The Captain enforces all department and United States Coast Guard rules and regulations and those of other cognizant regulatory bodies.</p>		
Qualification Requirements		
<p>A valid U. S. Coast Guard License as Master of Coastwise steam or motor vessels of at least 3,200 gross tons, or a higher license; plus a Radio-Telephone Third Class Operator's Permit for operation of a ship radio station issued by the Federal Communication Commission. In addition, all candidates must obtain a valid First Class Pilot's License on all waters sailed by the department's sludge boats within a year following appointment. This includes pilot age for navigating waters leading to PVSC.</p>

<p>Captain must have supervisory skills. Captain will be responsible for navigating crews in any DEP marine vessel.</p>
